Here are the steps we are taking:

\*We are scheduled to open for play Mar 28th/2020 however we will require our employees to stay home if they feel unwell or if they have been in contact with anyone that is exhibiting flu-like symptoms.

\*Bar and Restaurant will not be opening at this time.

\*Increased cleanliness of our facilities especially in high traffic areas.

\*Notices throughout the facility for customers and employees to use caution and practice best hygiene methods to prevent the spread of the virus.

\*Once riding carts are available it will be single rider only unless travelled to course together, pull cart handles will be sanitized as well as riding carts.

\*There will be no benches or sand rakes on the course.

\*Players are not to touch the flags (pins) on the green and only putt to the hole, do not touch the cup.

\*Although golf is in a wide open, outdoor space and is the least at-risk scenario, we will encourage social distancing ( reduce close contact).

As the golf season approaches, Amherstview Golf Course Ltd. will continue to monitor the recommendations of government and health officials as well as industry best practices and pass along relevant information and updates as necessary.
